This petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.139 dated 19.03.2020, under Sections 363/366-A IPC, registered at Police Station, Rania, District Sirsa.

A perusal of the statement made by daughter of the complainant under Section 164 Cr.P.C. shows that she is 17 years and 03 months old. In her statement, the prosecutrix stated that the present petitioner is her schoolmate and they both had gone without informing their parents. When they reached at Bus Stand, Nakodar, police started questioning them.

The petitioner is 20 years of age.

Learned State counsel, on instructions, informs that challan has already been presented and 09 prosecution witnesses are to be examined. The petitioner is in custody since 21.03.2020.

Heard.

Keeping in view the period of incarceration of the petitioner

and the fact that trial may still take some time for its conclusion, this court feels that there is no need to detain the petitioner any longer. Accordingly, this petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be enlarged on bail to the satisfaction of Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Sirsa.
