The present petition has been filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking directions to the respondents to initiate a fair and proper investigation in FIR No.88 dated 08.05.2020 under Sections 447/511/302/506/120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Dirba, District Sangrur. It has been further prayed that the investigation be handed over to the Central Bureau of Investigation.

On the other hand, learned counsel for the State, on instructions from ASI Gurdev Singh, has submitted that in this case, investigation was handed over to the Superintendent of Police, Investigation, who has already submitted his report on 11.06.2020

declaring four accused persons as innocent whereas two accused persons have already been arrested. One accused person is yet to be arrested. He further submits that the Police report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. against two accused persons has already been submitted in the Court on 06.07.2020 under Sections 304, 447, 427, 511 and 34 of the Indian Penal Code.

On this, learned counsel for the petitioner prays that he may be permitted to withdraw the present petition with the liberty to file appropriate application before the Court.

In view thereof, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty as aforesaid.
