The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 127 dated 04.06.2020, registered under Section 306 IPC at Police Station City 1 Sangrur, District Sangrur.

The operative part of the order dated 09.07.2020, vide which the petitioners have been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Inter alia contends that although the daughter-Rajveer Kaur of the deceased-Sanjeev Kumar solemnized the marriage with Vikasdeep (brother of the petitioners), but they have no role at all in the commission of the alleged offence.

Notice of motion for 25.11.2020.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners, in pursuance to the order dated 09.07.2020, have already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and have joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on telephonic instructions from

the Investigating Officer, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 09.07.2020, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
