This is a petition for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. on behalf of the petitioner, in case FIR No.131 dated 12.07.2019, under Sections 307, 506, 328, 148, 149, 323 and 120-B of the IPC, registered at Police Station Bass, District Hisar, Haryana.

[2]. The petitioner is a old man aged about 70 years. There is no allegation in the FIR of any injury to any person being actually inflicted by him. Although, he is alleged to have been present alongwith the other accused persons at the time of occurrence.

[3]. Interestingly, in the FIR the complainant has stated that one day prior to the date of occurrence (dated 11.07.2019) a meeting had been held by the accused persons in the house of one Satbir in which allegedly a plan was hatched to kill the complainant's brother-Kapil. But it is not clear, how the complainant was privy to such secret meeting, which, undoubtedly, was not held in his own house and there is no indication as to how he gathered

knowledge about the same. Other accused persons in the case have already been granted bail by this Court namely- Anil, Ramesh, and Rinku, vide CRM-M-Nos. 16421 of 2020, CRM-M-16787 of 2020 and CRM-M-12358 of 2020, respectively.

[4] The petitioner who is an old man by now has remained in detention since 15.05.2020.

[5]. In such circumstances and considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, he is ordered to be released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
