The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

Prayer in the instant petition is for issuance of a direction to the respondents to issue registration certificates in favour of the petitioners pursuant to their applications, Annexures P-11 to P-15, respectively.

Learned counsel states that at this stage, he would be satisfied, in case, a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider and decide the representation dated 05.03.2020 (Annexure P-17).

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Sanjay Mittal, Addl.A.G., Haryana, accepts notice.

Heard.

Having regard to the prayer made and without adverting to the merits of the instant petition, the same is disposed of with a direction to respondent No3-Registrar, Haryana State Pharmacy Council, 87, 2nd Floor, Sector 4, Panchkula, to consider and decide the representation dated 05.03.2020 (Annexure P-17), as per law, within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioners is admissible to them, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to them, within a period of two weeks thereafter. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioners is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
