All the cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the Covid-19 pandemic.

On July 27, 2020, the following order had been passed:-

“All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Despite the matter having been passed over, none appears for the petitioners even on 2nd call.

However, Mr. Bansal, learned D.A.G., Haryana, submits that a reply has been filed on behalf of the State, by the Deputy Superintendent of Police, Ambala, a perusal of which shows that the statements of both the petitioners, as also the father of petitioner no. 1, were recorded by ASI Surinder Kumar, on 16.07.2020, with all of them stating that the petitioners had got married to each other of their own free will, they being of the age of majority and with them understanding what is good or bad for them.

As per the DSP, the petitioners are under no threat because petitioner no. 1 is residing in Ambala, whereas petitioner no. 2 residing in the area of Jagdish Pura, District Agra (U.P.), and that in fact the brother of petitioner no. 2 has got registered an FIR at Police Station Jagdish Pura, (alleging therein that his sister has been kidnapped).

Learned counsel for the petitioners not having appeared, adjourned to 07.08.2020.”

Today, learned counsel appearing for the petitioners, submits that the petitioners no longer require protection and therefore this petition has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of as such.

Ordered accordingly.
