Counsel for State of Punjab would inform that needful has been done and registration certificate in respect of registration No.PBM-0001 has already been issued in the name of petitioner Joginder Gill. He would further state that he has forwarded copy of registration certificate of the aforesaid number in the name of petitioner Joginder Gill.

Counsel for the petitioner would state that documents of registration may be handed over to the petitioner. He has further submitted that in para 17(ii) of the petition, the petitioner has also prayed for issuance of direction to allow transfer of vehicle with registration No.PBM-0001 in the name of daughter of the petitioner.

Perusal of averments raised in the petition and facts noticed in order dated 16.07.2020 makes it apparent that main grievance of the petitioner was that aforesaid number is not being registered in the name of petitioner despite completing formalities. The question of transfer of this registration number in favour of daughter of the petitioner would arise only once the petitioner has been allowed the necessary relief of registration of this number in her name. The petitioner may take to recourse to appropriate remedy for transfer of this number in the name of her daughter, in accordance with law. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to collect the necessary documents from the office of concerned authority.
