Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Petitioner is a lady. As per averments made in the petition she was married to one Charanjit Singh son of Beant Singh and who died in a motor accident on 18.6.2016.

Instant writ petition has been filed raising a two fold grievance.

(i) It is alleged that the petitioner has been forcibly thrown out of a residential house that had been constructed by her deceased husband. Allegations are against the immediate blood relations of her deceased husband.

Second prayer is with regard to protection of life and liberty of the petitioner and by voicing an apprehension and threat to the same at the hands of her father-in-law, mother-in-law, brother-in-law and sister-in-laws.

Counsel for the petitioner has been heard at length.

In so far as the alleged eviction of the petitioner from the house in question, no interference in the present proceedings is warranted. Suffice it to observe that it would be open for the petitioner to avail of her legal

remedies in such regard as may be available in accordance with law.

In so far as the second prayer of protection of life and liberty is concerned, it would be open for the petitioner to approach respondent no.4 i.e. the S.S.P., Tarn Taran, district Tarn Taran and in the eventuality of doing so, respondent no.4 would be obligated to look into the same and thereafter to take steps as may be warranted in law.

Disposed of.
