The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.112 dated 08.04.2020, under Sections 148, 149, 188, 269, 270, 323, 332, 353, 354, 506 and 307 of the I.P.C., Sections 51 and 57 of Disaster Management Act and Section 3 of Pandemic Disease Act No.3 of 1987, registered at Police Station Sector 14, Panchkula.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 08.04.2020. Thereafter, investigation against him has since been completed and challan submitted.

[3]. In such circumstances and without commenting upon the other merits of the case, at this stage, this Court is of the opinion that further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period is not justified. As such, he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to the appropriate terms and

conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
