The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.303 dated 04.08.2019, under Sections 20-B, 27-A, 61 of the NDPS Act and Section 201 IPC, registered at Police Station Rewari, District Rewari.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR and no recovery has been effected from him. He further contends that the petitioner has been arraigned as an accused on the statement of the co-accused, from whom, 60 kg 'gaanja patti' was recovered. He also contends that the petitioner is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act and is in custody for almost 6 months.

Learned State counsel contends that although challan has been filed but charges are yet to be framed.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when no recovery has been effected from the petitioner, he is not involved in any other case under the NDPS Act, he is in custody for almost 6 months, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
