ARVIND SINGH SANGWAN, J. (Oral)

The petitioners pray for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.63 dated 30.06.2020, registered under Sections 326, 341, 34 IPC at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the petitioners, at the very outset, seeks permission to withdraw this petition *qua* petitioner No.2 – Gurpreet Singh with liberty to petitioner No.2 to surrender before the trial Court and further submits that the trial Court be directed to decide the regular bail application of petitioner No.2 expeditiously.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty aforesaid *qua* petitioner No.2 only.

In case the petitioner No.2 surrenders before the trial Court within a period of 01 week from today and apply for regular bail, the trial Court will dispose of the regular bail application of petitioner No.2 – Gurpreet Singh within a period of 02 days thereafter.

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Counsel for the petitioner has further argued that petitioner No.1 – Jasvir Singh, has registered a cross-version on account of sustaining 05 blunt injuries, at the instance of the complainant party i.e. FIR No.63 dated 30.06.2020 registered under Sections 323/341/34 IPC, at Police Station Doraha, Police District Khanna. Counsel for petitioner No.1 has further submitted that as per the allegations in the present FIR, the injury invoking Section 326 IPC is attributed to his son – Gurpreet Singh and no specific injury is attributed to petitioner No.1 – Jasvir Singh.

Counsel for the complainant, has submitted that the cross-version is registered under Sections 326/355/34 IPC.

Counsel for the State has also submitted that the grievous injury is attributed to petitioner No.2 – Gurpreet Singh, *qua* whom the petition stands dismissed as withdrawn.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed qua petitioner No.1 only, and the petitioner No.1 – Jasvir is directed to appear before the Investigating Officer within a period of 10 days from today, to join the investigation and he shall be released on interim bail on furnishing bail/surety bonds subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
