The petitioner prays for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 56 dated 01.09.2019, registered under Sections 379-B, 506, 323 and 427 of the IPC at Police Station Dhilwan, District Kapurthala.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties and the petitioner has already filed a petition bearing CRM-M-45650-2019 seeking quashing of the present FIR on the basis of the compromise, in which notice of motion has been issued.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further submits that the petitioner is a first offender and he is not involved in any other case. It is further submitted that there is no specific allegation against the petitioner in the FIR.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Sidakmeet S. Sandhu, AAG, Punjab, who is also appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and does not dispute the factual position. He also submits that

petitioner is not involved in any other case.

In view of the above, without commenting anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is granted concession of anticipatory bail subject to conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

However, it will be open for the Investigating Officer to call upon the petitioner to join investigation, if required, by issuing a written notice in this regard.
