The instant Petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Anticipatory Bail in case FIR No.23, dated 15.02.2020, registered under Sections 307/326/325/323/341/506/336/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Nehianwala, District Bathinda.

2. The Petitioner is alleged to have attacked the Complainant/Victim along with his other accomplice. The specific role imputed to the Petitioner is of having attempted to hit on the head of the Victim with a handpump handle, which, however, landed on the Victim's biceps leading to causing fracture injury to him.

3. Submission of Ld. Counsel for the Petitioner, in this regard, is that the occurrence had taken place “at the spur of moment” after a dispute had occurred earlier with regard to playing of music on the previous night.

4. In the opinion of this Court, considering the nature of injury suffered by the Victim which has been specifically attributed to the Petitioner, this is not a fit case to grant him the concession of Anticipatory Bail.

5. Dismissed.
