This is a writ petition that has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a direction in the nature of certiorari for quashing of orders dated 23.05.2020 being illegal and arbitrary.

Counsel for the petitioner would submit that the instant matter is squarely covered by the decision of this court rendered in ***CWP No.6354 of 2016*** titled as ***“Balwinder Singh and others vs. State of Punjab and others”*** decided on 24.05.2018.

At this stage, counsel for the respondent-State very fairly submits that the claim of the petitioners herein would be considered in the light of the judgment that has been passed by this court.

In view of the very fair statement made, the instant writ petition is ordered to be treated as a representation of the petitioners and the respondent-State is directed to consider and decide the same by passing a speaking order in the light of the aforesaid decision rendered by this court in ***Balwinder Singh's case (supra)*** within a period of two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. In case, the petitioners are entitled to the benefits, the same be released within a period of two months thereafter.

Disposed of accordingly.
