LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioners are aggrieved of the action of respondents no.5 to 8 in throwing cow dung and waste in front of their house and are further aggrieved of the inaction on the part of the authorities despite submission of representations by the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the petitioner is, however, unable to point out any representation/application in terms of the provisions of the Haryana Panchayati Raj Act, submitted before the Gram Panchayat. Furthermore the mode and manner of submission of the representation dated 03.03.2020 (Annexure P-4) to the Deputy Commissioner, Yamunanagar at Jagadhri is not forthcoming. The present writ petition is, thus, premature and the same is disposed of as such.

Needless to say, the petitioners are at liberty to approach the competent authorities with their grievance, who shall look into the same, keeping in view the specific provisions of law as well as the decision of a Division Bench of this Court reported in 2019(4) Law Herald 2847 *Court on its own motion Vs. Union of India.*
