The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.128 dated 22.9.2019, registered at Police Station Bhupani, District Faridabad, under Sections 363, 366-A IPC and Section 4 of POCSO Act, 2012.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 28.9.2019. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 04 PWs, out of a total of 17 PWs, have been examined till date. The case of the petitioner is that of a run-away couple, thus, he deserves to be granted regular bail.

The factual submissions made by counsel for the petitioner have not been controverted by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the custody period as well as the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
