Through the present petition filed under Articles 226/227
of the Constitution of India, the petitioners seek a direction to count
their daily wage service as Special Police Officer (SPO) rendered by
them before regularization as qualifying service for the purpose of
pensionary/retiral benefits.

The claim is based upon the judgment dated 15.2.2018
passed in **CWP No.9936 of 2017-Sukhjeet Singh and others Vs.
State of Punjab and others (Annexure P/7)** in which reliance has
been placed upon the Division Bench judgment in **CWP No.2371 of
2010-Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab** and which has been followed
in **CWP No.24472 of 2015-Constable Rajesh Kumar Vs. State of
Punjab.**

Counsel for the petitioners at the outset submits that he would be satisfied if the legal notice dated 19.3.2020 (Annexure P/11) served upon the respondents by the petitioners is decided in time bound frame.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Abhey Pal Singh, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents. He points out that the petitioners belong to separate districts and they should file separate representations before the concerned Commissioner of Police/Senior Superintendent of Police so that appropriate action can be taken.

Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioners to submit their separate representations giving their details as such to the the concerned Commissioner of Police/Senior Superintendent of Police within a period of three weeks from today. If such representations is made within prescribed time, the concerned Commissioner of Police/Senior Superintendent of Police would then take appropriate action qua the petitioners who fall within their jurisdiction and pass necessary speaking order within a period of three months thereafter. In case the petitioners are found entitled for the relief, the same be disbursed them thereafter. In case the petitioners are found not entitled to the relief claimed, then speaking order be passed and conveyed to the concerned petitioners.
