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**B.S. Walia, J. (VC)**

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner is an NRI and is resident of Canada, presently in India but has to go abroad for surgery of her knees. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner has already concluded her evidence and now the case is fixed for the evidence of the respondent-defendant and that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied, if the revision petition is disposed of by directing the learned trial Court to conclude the proceeding, as expeditiously as possible.
3. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy, the revision petition is ***disposed of*** by directing the learned trial Court to consider and decide the matter, in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible. Needless to mention, it would be open to the petitioner to take all points as are available to her before the learned trial Court, in accordance with law.
