This petition has been filed under Section 226 of the Constitution of India read with Section 482 Cr.P.C., for issuance of writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for releasing detinue namely, Khushi Verma, Jyoti and Mohit (minor daughters and son of petitioner) by appointing a Warrant Officer.

Pursuant to notice, reply dated 21.07.2020 on behalf of respondent No.3 has been filed. In the reply, it is stated that statements of minor children have been recorded, wherein they have stated that they do not want to reside with their father Jai Pal Verma-petitioner. They want to live with their mother Sonia. They also want to proceed in due course for their legal rights. Statement of Sonia has also been recorded to the same effect. Keeping in view the statement of minor children and their mother, a

by SHO, Police Station, Sadar Ambala and the said complaint was placed before the Superintendent of Police, Ambala, for further necessary action. On enquiry, the complaint was ordered to be filed vide order dated 03.06.2020. It is further stated that after getting copy of the petition, local police again contacted Smt. Sonia Verma wife of Jai Pal and his minor children Khushi, Jyoti and Mohit on 16.07.2020. They made statement that they are fed up with the cruel behaviour of their father Jai Pal with them and their mother Sonia. They do not want to live with their father. Now, they are living happily with their mother-Sonia. They also informed that they had come to their mother Sonia at Durga Nagar, Ambala City on 26.05.2020 after being fed up with the cruel behaviour of their father (petitioner).

Keeping in view the reply filed, no further direction is required to be issued in this petition.

Disposed of accordingly.
