The petitioner seeks grant of regular bail in case FIR No. 171 dated 04.05.2020 registered under Section 21 of the NDPS Act, 1985, Sections 188, 269 IPC and Section 51(1)(b) of Disaster Management Act, 2005 at Police Station Asaudha (Bahadurgarh), District Jhajjar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that seven grams of Heroin was allegedly recovered from the petitioner which is marginally higher than the small quantity. The petitioner has been in custody for over three months and the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as charges have not yet been framed. Thus, the petitioner may be granted concession of regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 25.08.2020 has been presented in the Court. The same is taken on record. According to this custody certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 3 months and 20 days and there is no other criminal case pending against him.

In view of the above, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the petitioner is directed to

be released on regular bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the

satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
