Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.14 dated 29.03.2019, registered under Section 22 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Kheri Naudh Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib.

Petitioner is facing trial in aforesaid FIR for alleged recovery of 900 Lomotil tablets, which falls under the category of “commercial quantity”.

Learned State counsel contends that apart from the present case, petitioner was booked in two more cases of NDPS Act, out of which he has been acquitted in one and the other is pending.

Considering this aspect that petitioner is a habitual offender, this court is not inclined to entertain the instant second

petition for grant of bail to the petitioner more particularly when no new ground is made out.

Dismissed.

After pronouncing the order of dismissal, learned counsel for petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.
