AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Petitioners have approached this Court with a prayer that there is threat to their lives and liberty at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8 and, therefore, they have approached to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran-respondent No.2 through representation dated 02.07.2020 (Annexure P-5). He prays that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, as also the Station House Officer, Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn-Taran, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to consider and take a decision on the said representation dated 02.07.2020 (Annexure P-5) for providing them necessary protection of their lives and liberty.

Counsel for the State informs the Court that FIR No.19, dated 09.02.2020 has been registered against petitioner No.2 at Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn Taran.

Be that as it may, the fact remains that the due process of law has to take its course and the lives and liberty of the petitioners need to be

protected. Accordingly, a direction is issued to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, as also the Station House Officer, Police Station Sarhali, District Tarn-Taran, respondent Nos.2 and 3 respectively, to consider and take a decision on the representation dated 02.07.2020 (Annexure P-5) as submitted by the petitioners so that their lives and liberty are not put to peril at the hands of respondent Nos.4 to 8. It is made clear that law will take its own course and respondent Nos.2 and 3 are required to proceed in accordance with law.

The writ petition stands disposed of with the above directions/observations.
