The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

By filing this petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., petitioner has sought anticipatory bail in FIR No. 213 dated 10.9.2019 registered under Sections 323, 341, 452, 307, 379, 506, 148, 149 IPC and under Section 20 of Arms Act, 1959 at Police Station Tanda, District Hoshiarpur. Section 325 IPC added later on vide order dated 26.8.2020 of this Court.

Vide order dated 13.7.2020, petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail and was directed to join investigation. Thereafter, petitioner has joined investigation. The alleged weapons of offence namely datar, baseball bat and stick have been recovered. Further, a jeep, a mobile phone and Rs. 7000/- have also been recovered.

On instructions from ASI Jagdeep Singh, learned State counsel submitted that petitioner has joined investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Order dated 13.7.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to petitioner is made absolute. However petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so by Investigating Agency and shall abide by conditions of Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
