The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.03 dated 18.05.2020, under Sections 399 and 402 of the Indian Penal Code ('IPC' - for short); Section 27 of the NDPS Act and Section 25 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station State Special Operation Cell (SSOC), Fazilka, District Fazilka.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged that the petitioner along with others had constituted a gang and were indulging in illegal activities. However, neither any overt act has been attributed to the petitioner nor any recovery has been effected from him.

A coordinate Bench of this Court, by the order dated 14.07.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from SI Kamaljeet Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 14.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
