1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Sections 11 & 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondents for intentionally, willfully and deliberately disobeying order dated 21.11.2019 in CWP No.14656 of 2019.

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 21.11.2019, CWP No.14656 of 2019 was disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the claim made in representation dated 15.03.2019 within 03 months of receipt of certified copy of the order and on account of failure of respondent No.1 to do the needful, the instant contempt petition was filed.

4. Learned State Counsel on the other hand has placed on record reply along with order (Annexure R-1) dated 21.08.2020, rejecting representation

dated 15.03.2019 submitted by the petitioners.

5. Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of order (Annexure R-1) dated 21.08.2020, he may be permitted to withdraw the contempt petition, with liberty to challenge order (Annexure R-1) dated 21.08.2020 by way of appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law.

6. The same is not opposed by learned State Counsel.

7. In view of the statement of learned counsel for the petitioners, the contempt petition is ***dismissed as withdrawn***, with the liberty, as prayed for.
