The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Deeksha Singh and Bobby, the petitioners before this Court, claim themselves to be major. They have pleaded that they have married against the wishes of respondents No.4 to 9 and seek protection to their life and liberty. They apprehend danger from respondents No.4 to 9. They have placed on record marriage certificate and photographs, Annexures P-3 and P4 respectively, evidencing their marriage. The petitioners have submitted a representation, Annexure P5 to Superintendent of Police, Panchkula and S.H.O., Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula.

Without entering upon an exercise to evaluate the evidentiary value of the documents placed on the file, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondents No.2 and 3 to decide the representation of the petitioners, Annexure P-5 and grant them protection, if any threat to their

life and liberty is perceived. It is made clear that this order shall not be taken to protect the petitioners from legal action for violation of law if any committed by them.
