The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.37 dated 20.3.2020, registered at Women Police Station, Yamuna Nagar, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 323, 376, 377 and 506 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody since 20.3.2020. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as even, charges have not been framed as yet. The case is one of consensual relationship and thus, the petitioner may be granted regular bail.

Learned State counsel concedes that charges have not been framed as yet and that according to the allegations in the FIR, the parties were involved in a consensual relationship for the last four years.

Keeping in view the fact that the trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date and in view of the nature of the allegations made
