**SANT PARKASH, J.**

Present Review Application under Sections 114 and 151 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed by the applicant, seeking review of the final judgment dated 10.06.2020 (R-1) passed by this Court, whereby the Letters Patent Appeal has been dismissed in limine.

After having heard the learned senior counsel for the review applicant and perusing the judgment passed in the main appeal as well as the averments made in the review application, no patent illegality in the judgment sought to be reviewed has been pointed out.

We find no substance in the argument of learned senior counsel that the main appeal has been decided without taking into consideration the submissions made in the petition. The averments taken in the main appeal and arguments raised at the time of hearing were taken into consideration while deciding the main appeal. The applicant wanted to re-argue the matter afresh again which is not within the scope of the review application. The review does not mean rehearing of the case and the scope of power of

review is very limited. The power of review can be exercised only if the Court is satisfied that there is an error apparent on the face of the order, which has resulted into miscarriage of justice.

In view of the above, we do not find any error apparent on the face of the record. No ground is made out to interfere in the judgment sought to be reviewed.

Accordingly, the review application is dismissed.
