[1] Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.

[2] Prayer in the writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for the issuance of a writ of Mandamus for directing respondent No.1 to decide the application for stay, Annexure P/4 in ROR-716/2018-19 dated 06.07.2020, in case titled as "Suraj Bhan and Ors. V. Umed Singh and Ors." and further to direct respondent No.2 not to implement the partition proceedings and dispossess the petitioner from the land in dispute during the pendency of stay application and revision petition before respondent No.1.

[3] Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only.

[4] Ms. Rajni Gupta, Addl. A.G., Haryana, who is present, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and having gone over the advance copy of the writ petition supplied to her as also on the basis of instructions from respondent No.1, states that the writ petition can be disposed of by granting two weeks time to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the application for stay as has been filed by the petitioner on 06.07.2020 (i.e. Annexure P/4).

[5] The same satisfies learned counsel for the petitioner.

[6] In view of the position as noted above, the writ petition is disposed of by directing respondent No.1 to consider and decide the

application for stay, Annexure P/4 dated 06.07.2020 in ROR-716/2018-19 in case titled as “Suraj Bhan&Ors. V. Umed Singh &Ors.” on or before 24.07.2020. However, till such time the decision is taken on the application for stay (i.e. Annexure P/4), status quo as is prevailing on date be maintained.
