1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Prayer in the petition under Section 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971, is for initiating action against the respondent for willful and intentional disobedience of order (Annexure P-1) dated 15.01.2020 in CWP No.872 of 2020 in case titled as '**Paramjit Singh**versus**Punjab Water Supply and Sewerage Board.**'

3. Learned counsel contends that vide order dated 15.01.2020, CWP No.872 of 2020 was disposed of by directing the respondent to decide the claim made in legal notice dated 04.11.2019 by passing a speaking order within 03 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order and in view of the respondent having decided the claim made by the petitioner and released him substantial payment on account of the same, he does not press the contempt petition and may be permitted to withdraw the

same, with liberty to pursue the matter with the authorities for release of the remaining payment as also to take legal recourse to legal remedy, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant.

4. The same is not opposed by learned counsel for the respondent.

5. In the light of the statements of learned counsel for the parties, the contempt petition is ***disposed of*** as not pressed, with the liberty to the petitioner to pursue the matter with the authorities for release of the remaining payment as per entitlement claimed as also to take out appropriate proceedings, in accordance with law, if the circumstances of the case, so warrant.
