Status report by way of affidavit of Davinder Singh, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Sub Division Balachaur, District SBS Nagar on behalf of respondents No.1 to 5 has been received online.

Counsel representing the respondents, in terms of reply/status report, would argue that statement of Daulat Ram petitioner No.1 was recorded on 02.08.2020 wherein he had stated that they left the house due to fear and do not need any security and would file a fresh application to local police in case there is any threat in future.

Counsel for the petitioners would state that Daulat Ram is an illiterate person who never suffered any such statement relied upon by the respondents and appended with the reply as Annexure R-5/T. He would pray that directions may be issued to the concerned police station which is at a distance of approximately 4 kms from house of the petitioner that one of the police officials would visit house of the petitioner on an alternate day or twice a week in view of directions to be issued by this Court.

Counsel for the petitioners was directed to get file an affidavit of Sh. Daulat Ram with regard to challenge to the statement Annexure R-5/T but he did not respond.

Taking into consideration the status report along with Annexures R-1/T to R-5/T, no further action is required in the matter.

Disposed of accordingly.

However, in case the petitioners entertain any apprehension in

future, they would be at liberty to file an appropriate application before the police authorities.
