GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Kamal Kant Sharma and Vidhi, stated to be aged 46 & 19 years respectively, have filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners at the hands of respondents No.4 to 10 and not to interfere in their married life.

Records of the case show that on 15.07.2020, this Court had issued notice of motion and directed the State counsel to apprise this Court that if any FDR/DDR stands registered against petitioner No.1 at the instance of private respondents. On instructions from SI Mukesh, learned State counsel informs that there is no FIR that has been registered by the private respondents against petitioner No.1.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that for the same/similar grievance, they had submitted a representation dated 08.07.2020 (Annexure P-7). He submits that a direction may be given to the Competent Authority to examine the representation, so that in case, there is any threat perception, appropriate action may be taken in accordance with law.

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-7) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by Superintendent of Police, District Ambala (respondent No.2), expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to Superintendent of Police, District Ambala (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
