GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners-Pooja and Joginder Kumar, stated to be both aged 21 years, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for directing respondents No.2 & 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 & 5 and not to interfere in their married life.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a detailed representation (Anexxure P-4) was submitted to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, District Sirsa (Haryana) (respondent No.2).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of**

with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-4) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, District Sirsa (Haryana) (respondent No.2), expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to Superintendent of Police, Sirsa, District Sirsa (Haryana) (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
