The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in FIR No.117, dated 20.06.2020 registered at Police Station Sadar Bathinda, District Bathinda, under Sections 379, 427, 506, 148, 149 IPC and 25/27 of Arms Act, 1959.

2. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Gurmeet Singh submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and has been cooperating therewith.

3. Accordingly, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 24.07.2020, is made absolute subject to compliance of conditions enshrined under Section 438(2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973, by him.

4. Learned counsel for the complainant argues that affidavit (Annexure A-2) has not been complied with as the pipeline has not been removed.

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5. This is disputed by learned counsel for the petitioner.
6. In case the pipeline has not been removed, the complainant is at liberty to move an appropriate application.
