GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of lockdown due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioners makes an oral request that in memo of parties, it has inadvertently been mentioned as SSP, District Ludhiana instead of SSP, Sangrur and the same may be corrected.

Request is accepted.

Respondent No.2 be read as SSP, Sangrur.

Registry is directed to carry out necessary corrections.

Petitioners-Jaspreet Kaur and Hitesh Kumar, stated to be aged 26 & 29 years respectively, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 & 3 to protect life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned Counsel for the petitioners submits that in this regard, a detailed representation (Annexure P-5) was submitted to Superintendent of Police, Sangrur, District Sangrur (respondent No.2).

While refraining from making any expression as regards the veracity of the averments made in the petition, the petition is **disposed of** with a direction that in case, the petitioners approach the police authorities concerned, with above representation (Annexure P-5) with regard to their alleged threat perception, the same shall be got examined by Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No.2), expeditiously in accordance with law and necessary steps as may be warranted under the facts and circumstances of the case, be taken thereupon forthwith.

A copy of this order be sent to Superintendent of Police, Sangrur (respondent No.2), so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.

Needless to say that the aforesaid order shall not be construed to be an expression as regards the validity of the alleged marriage of the parties.

Criminal Writ Petition is disposed of accordingly.
