Instant contempt petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Court's Act, 1971 for willful and deliberate disobedience of the order dated 10.01.2020 (Annexure P-1) passed by this Court in ***CWP No.23575 of 2015*** titled as ***Amit Kataria and others vs. State of Punjab and others.***

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that even after a lapse of seven months, the respondents had failed to recast the selection list of the selected candidates within the stipulated time of three months as directed by this Court in the aforementioned writ petition.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Copy of paper book has already been supplied to her.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Vimal Shingari, Sr. Assistant, Office of Director, Secondary Education, Mohali, submits that the State has decided to file Letters Patent Appeal against the order dated 10.01.2020 qua which violation has been alleged in the instant contempt petition. Learned State counsel has further submitted that the respondents

be granted a period of four weeks within which the order dated 10.01.2020 passed by this Court in CWP No.23575 of 2015 would be implemented in case no interim order is passed in favour of the respondents in the said LPA, which the State is proposing to file shortly.

Learned counsel for the petitioner keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the State, submits that he does not want to press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as not pressed. Needless to say that the respondents shall be bound by the statement made by learned counsel for the State in the Court today.
