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HARINDER SINGH SIDHU, J.

The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 36 dated 1.4.2019, registered under Sections 15, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985 at Police Station Dasuya, District Hoshiarpur.

The allegations against petitioner are that 250 kg poppy husk was recovered from truck which petitioner was allegedly driving.

During the pendency of this petition, petitioner has filed CRM-24858-2020 seeking interim bail to enable him to perform ceremonies on account of death of his mother. Taking that into account, vide order dated 16.10.2020, petitioner was directed to be released on interim bail for a period of 10 days from 18.10.2020 to 2.11.2020. He was directed to surrender before jail authorities on or before 2.11.2020 at 5.00 pm.

Learned counsel for petitioner states that as per his information, petitioner has failed to surrender before jail authorities as directed. Consequently, vide order dated 4.12.2020, the Court of learned Additional Sessions Judge, Hoshiarpur has directed issuance of non bailable warrants for arrest of petitioner. Notices have also been issued to surety and his identifier and report regarding property verification of surety has also been called for.

In view thereof, this petition is dismissed.

The trial Court may proceed further in accordance with law to secure presence of petitioner.
