The petitioners seek anticipatory bail in connection with FIR No. 186 dated 02.06.2020 on the file of Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar, registered under Sections 420, 409 and 120-B IPC.

The petitioners were implicated in the alleged offence by the named accused in the FIR. The allegations against the petitioners are of such nature, that the records available with them would have to be examined to ascertain the facts. Their custodial interrogation may not be necessary at

this stage. They would therefore be entitled to relief, subject to conditions.

The petition is accordingly allowed directing the release of the petitioners on bail in the event of their arrest in FIR No. 186 dated 02.06.2020 on the file of Police Station Maqboolpura, Amritsar, subject to the petitioners furnishing personal bonds for a sum of Rs. 50,000/- each along with two sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer. Further, the petitioners shall co-operate with the investigation and shall abide by all the other conditions prescribed under Section 438(2).
