Instant contempt petition has been filed under Section 12 of the Contempt of Court's Act, 1971 for willful and deliberate disobedience of the order dated 21.11.2018 passed by this Court in ***CWP No.29483 of 2018*** titled as ***Satish Kumar Goyal vs. State of Punjab and others.***

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 21.11.2018 this Court had ordered the respondents to decide the legal notice dated 07.09.2018 by passing an appropriate order within three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the order. However, the respondents had been sitting over the matter for more than a year. He further submits that after passing of the aforesaid order, the petitioner had been visiting the offices of the respondents and sending emails including the demand notice dated 24.01.2020, however, the respondents had failed to act on the same.

Notice of motion.

Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. AG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Copy of paper book has already been supplied to her.

Learned State counsel submits that in case no order has been passed, the respondents would implement the order dated 21.11.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.29483 of 2018 within four weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner keeping in view the submission made by learned counsel for the State, submits that he does not want to press the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such.

Accordingly, the present petition stands disposed of as not pressed. Needless to add that the respondents shall be bound by the statement made by learned counsel for the State in the Court today. It is made clear that in case there is any violation of the above recorded statement of the respondent-State and the same is brought to the notice of this Court, a strict view would be taken against the respondents.
