The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.629 dated 14.7.2018, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat, under Sections 201, 302, 396, 120-B and 34 IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner is identically situated as co-accused, namely, Arjun, who has been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 23.7.2020 passed in CRM-16572-2020 in/and CRM-M-35468-2019. Thus, the same concession be granted to the petitioner as well.

Learned State counsel is unable to controvert the submission made on behalf of the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the complainant opposes the prayer on the ground that a heinous offence of murder has been committed. He is, however, not able to contradict submissions made on behalf of the petitioner.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case and on the principle of parity, I deem it appropriate to allow this petition.

Accordingly, the petition is allowed and petitioner is ordered to be released

on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
