Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 CrPC is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.132 dated 15.04.2019 under Section 61(1) of the Punjab Excise Act, 1914 registered at Police Station Phillaur, District Jalandhar.

Learned State counsel has apprised this Court that there are five more cases registered against the petitioner under the Excise Act, the details of which is as under:-

Excise Act, P.S. Phillaur;
- (iv) FIR No.405 dated 4.12.2019 under Section 61 of the
Excise Act, P.S. Phillaur;
- (v) FIR No.102 dated 28.4.2020 under Section 61 of the
Excise Act, P.S. Phillaur.’

In view of the aforesaid, no case for anticipatory bail is made
out.
