The present petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been filed by the petitioner seeking direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 5 to protect life and liberty of the family of the petitioner at the hands of respondent Nos. 6 to 8.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr.Suveer Sheokand, Addl.AG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State. A complete set of paper book has already been furnished to learned State counsel.

Without expressing any opinion with regard to validity of marriage and on the merits of the assertions made in the petition, the instant petition is disposed of with direction to the petitioner to appear before

respondent No.3- Senior Superintendent of Police, Fazilka within a week from today, who shall take necessary action on the representation dated 22.6.2020 (Annexure P-2) moved by the petitioner and provide necessary protection to the petitioner and his family members in accordance with law, in case, he is satisfied that the life and liberty of the petitioner's family are threatened at the hands of respondent Nos.6 to 8.
