The instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C., for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in the event of arrest in FIR No. 0085 dated 21.06.2020 under Sections 406 and 420 of the Indian Penal Code registered at Police Station Rahon, District Shaheed Bhagat Singh Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is falsely implicated in the present case. Pursuant to order dated 15.07.2020, he has joined investigation while also stating that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

Appearance has been caused by Mr. Raj Sumer Singh, Advocate on behalf of the complainant, who affirms the settlement between the parties

and does not oppose the granting of confirmation of bail.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kuldeep Singh, submits that petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for the custodial interrogation.

In view of the facts that the petitioner is not required for custodial interrogation and has joined the investigation, without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is allowed and order dated 15.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 Sub Section 2 Clauses (i) (ii) and (iii) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
