The petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in relation to FIR No.103 dated 14.08.2019 on the file of Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka, registered under Section 379 IPC (offence under Section 411 IPC added later on).

The case relates to theft of a motorcycle. The motorcycle was recovered at Delhi. The petitioner was implicated in the offence by one Tasleem at Delhi. As no recovery is to be effected at present, in the light of the seizure of the motorcycle at Delhi, it would suffice at this stage if the petitioner joins investigation.

The petition is accordingly allowed. The petitioner is directed to forthwith join investigation in FIR No.103 dated 14.08.2019 on the file of Police Station Bahawala, District Fazilka. In the event of his arrest in

connection with this case, he shall be released on bail upon furnishing a personal bond for a sum of Rs.20,000/- along with 2 sureties for a like sum each to the satisfaction of the Arresting/Investigating Officer. In such an event, he shall also abide by the conditions prescribed in Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
