This is a petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking quashing of order dated 30.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) rendered by Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Kapurthala, in terms of which, petitioner has been declared proclaimed offender in case FIR No. 57 dated 08.06.2018 (Annexure P-1), under Sections 148, 323, 336, 427 and 452 IPC read with Section 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act registered at Police Station Subhanpur, District Kapurthala.

Notice of motion.

Mr. J. S. Ghumman, Deputy Advocate General Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents-State.

Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

Learned counsel for the petitioner at the very outset submits

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that petitioner shall surrender before the Court concerned in above said case FIR within ten days positively from today. He further urges that on surrender, petitioner would move application seeking bail from Court concerned and the Court concerned may be directed to dispose of the said application at the earliest.

In view of above, instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.

Trial Court is directed that on surrender of petitioner in the instant case FIR, application for bail moved by him shall be disposed of at the earliest.
