The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure (for short, 'the Cr.P.C.') seeking regular bail in case FIR No.115, dated 15.08.2018, registered under Sections 22, 29 of NDPS Act, 1985, at Police Station Division E, District Police Commissionerate Amritsar.

2. Seen the CD containing the CCTV footage, tendered on behalf of Ld. Counsel for the petitioner, which indicates some discrepancy in the time and place of arrest of the petitioner. Admittedly, there is no record of the petitioner's involvement in any other case under the NDPS Act. He has remained in detention for almost 1½ years since the month of August, 2018.

3. Considering the overall circumstances, further detention, at this stage, would not serve any purpose. Therefore, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner, namely, Ashwani Arora, is ordered to be

released on regular bail subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
