All cases listed today have been taken up for hearing by way of video conferencing because of the situation existing due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Pursuant to the order dated 07.08.2020, an affidavit of the SSP, Police District Batala, has been sent to learned counsel for the petitioner, as also the Reader of this court by way of 'Whatsapp communication' (it not having been filed due to the short time available).

As regards the condition of the eyes of the alleged detainee, the opinion of the doctor, annexed with the affidavit, shows that both eyes are in normal condition.

It has also been stated in the affidavit that she stated that though she has got married to the petitioner, she no longer wishes to live with him and wishes to live with her parents.

That being so, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner does not press this petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.

However, learned counsel submits that in case any communication is received by the petitioner from his wife, i.e. Kamaljit Kaur, he may be permitted to avail of remedies available in law, at that stage.

Naturally, that liberty is always available to any person, with each legal proceeding to be examined on its own merits.
