The petitioner in the present petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C., seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.44 dated 24.06.2020 under Section 420 IPC registered at Police Station Jodhan, District Ludhiana.

Counsel for the State on instructions received from ASI Jaswinder Singh, submits that in pursuance of the order dated 15.07.2020, the petitioner has joined investigation and there is no other case against him.

The FIR lodged against the petitioner by Gurcharan Singh is to the extent that the petitioner had been elected as a Member Panchayat and was drawing pension being the widow of Jaspal Singh. Thereafter, in certain documents she described herself as wife of Darshan Singh, who is none else, but the brother of her husband. Therefore, the case was registered against her that she is playing fraud with the District Administration.

It is, thus, submitted that the all the documents are public documents and custodial interrogation is not required.

It is further the case of the petitioner that she has filed application for correction of the said errors, which was a inadvertent mistake created in the voter list, as her sister Baljit Kaur is married to

Darshan Singh and on account of synonymity with her name, the error had crept in.

Accordingly, the interim order dated 15.07.2020 is confirmed and the petition stands disposed off.
