The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.35 dated 09.04.2020, under Sections 307, 341, 323, 506, 148 and 149 of the IPC, registered at Police Station Naya Gaon, District SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 22.05.2020. Perusal of the FIR goes to show that the brick injury caused on the head of the victim/father of the complainant was imputed to co-accused Naresh and not the present petitioner.

[3]. In such circumstances, considering the long detention undergone by the petitioner, at this stage, he is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld.
