Case taken up through video conferencing.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI
Gurnam Singh states that the petitioner has since joined the investigation
and his custodial interrogation is not required.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that since
the petitioner has joined the investigation and as per statement of learned
State counsel the custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required,
therefore, the petition be accepted.

Though learned counsel appearing for the
complainant has opposed the petition but in view of the statement made
by the State counsel that as the accused has joined the investigation,
custodial interrogation of the petitioner is not required, the interim bail
granted to the petitioner on 27.7.2020 is made absolute, subject to his

fulfilling following conditions:

- (i) that the petitioner shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- (ii) that the petitioner shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- (iii) that the petitioner shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court; and
- (iv) that the petitioner shall surrender his passport before the Investigating Officer and if he is not having passport, then shall file the affidavit in that regard.

In case the petitioner violates any term and condition on which the bail has been granted to him, the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail to him.

The petition is allowed accordingly.
